Businesses will also learn the guidelines for conducting business with government and the many incentive programs available to small businesses.

For businesses that sell products, Miami-Dade Building Code Compliance staff will explain a service currently being offered to certify green products. In addition, Miami-Dade County's new Restaurant Certification Program will also be presented.

Trade show exhibitors can set up their tables from 7AM-8AM. Event registration, networking and the trade show begin at 8AM. The workshops will take place from 9:30AM to 12:30PM with a half-hour break. Trade show vendors will be available for the event's duration to educate attendees about green products and services until the event closes at 1:00PM.

The event is complimentary and will provide attendees with cutting-edge information on the financial and environmental benefits of greening operations. Event attendance is anticipated at 300 hotel and business executives, general managers and decision makers.
